Red Wine | Pinot Noir | Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy

Pinot Noir, or known in Italian as Pinot Nero, is an old grape variety that is believed to have originated in the Burgundy region of France about 2,000 years ago. This wine is made in stainless steel and does not undergo any oak aging or exposure producing a final wine that is a pure expression of Pinot Noir with an impressively long finish. It finds an excellent balance between fruit concentration and acidity.

Pinot Noir is a very versatile wine food pairing wine. Suggestions include: risotto, pasta, pizza, barley and bean soups, stews, roasts, poultry, mushrooms, and burgers.

The villa was built in 1860, and has a fascinating history from being German headquarters during World War II to the modern winery owned by the Puiatti family. In Latin the word parens means 'ancestors'; their wine is dedicated to those who accompany us and also when they are not with us. Villa Parens is creating new limited, refine and exclusive wines designed with simplicity and elegance to fascinate. "For the future of tradition."


